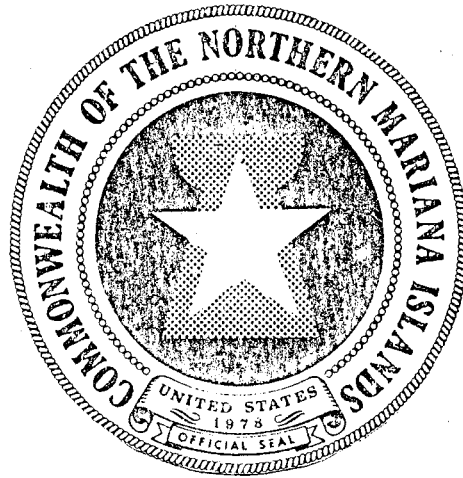

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATIONS FOR THE NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS.

The Director of the Department of Community and Cultural Affairs hereby adopts the amendment to the Regulations for the Administration of the Nutrition Assistance Program in the Northern Marianas which were proposed in the Commonwealth Register, December 1986 issue.

The purpose of this amendment is to modify policies and procedures embodied in the NAP Manual of Operation which pertains to the following subject area:

Eligibility of Households



PUBLIC NOTICE

ADOPTED REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS
PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 4-47
COMMONWEALTH UTILITIES CORPORATION

The Board of Directors of the Commonwealth Utilities Corporation has adopted these regulations governing the use of and connection to the public sewers.

The purpose of these regulations is to establish requirements for connection to public sewers when and where public sewers are available and to establish fees for the use of and connection to public sewers.

The adopted regulations include the following subject areas:

1. When residential and non-residential building must be connected to public sewers.
2. When a public sewer will be considered as being available for connection.
3. Design standards and requirements for the building wastewater line and its connection to the public sewer line.
4. Establishment of fees for sewer use and connection to a public sewer.
5. Sanctions and penalties for failure to connect to a public sewer when required, for failure to pay sewer charge and for any other violation of these regulations.

The proposed regulations were published in the Commonwealth Register of November 17, 1986 and two public hearings were conducted on the proposed Regulations. The CUC Board adopted these regulations on January 20, 1987.

Some minor changes were made on the proposed regulations.

They are:


1. Use Charges

The classification of "Residential" customers and "Non-residential" customers was eliminated. The minimum charge of \$5.00 per month was reduced to \$3.00 per billing cycle.

2. Deposits for Monthly Service Charges

The mandatory requirement that all customers should pay a deposit was modified to a discretionary requirement.

2. Hafa na kondision na para umakonsidera na guaha tubon publiko anai sina makumple i koneksion.
3. Maestablese un modelu yan areklo para i tubon hanom aplacha ginen i gima yan i mana cheton-na guato gi tubon publiko.
4. Maestablese i apas gi para mausan i tubon publiko yan apas koneksion para i tubon publiko. Koneksion guma familia guato ti tubon publiko umacho'gue sin apas.
5. Mutta yan pena pot ti makumple i koneksion guato gi tubon publiko anai debe esta de umacho'gue, pot ti ma-apase i maestablese na apas yan pot kuatkiet kontradiksion gi regulasion.

I mapropoposa na regulasion mapublika gi Commonwealth Register gi Noviembre 17, 1986, yan lokue dos na inekungok publika makondukta pot i mapropoposa na regulasion. I kuetpon Commonwealth Utilities Corporation (CUC) ha-adopta este na regulasion gi 20 de Enero, 1987.



PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CPA RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Part 12 of the Airport Rules and Regulations, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following section:

12.3.1 International Arrival Facility Service Charge

To cover the added costs of operations and maintenance of the arrival terminal building for international deplaned passengers at the Saipan International Airport, a service charge calculated on the basis of Two Dollars and Twenty Cents per revenue passenger shall be paid to the Authority by every aircraft operator transporting international revenue passengers to the Saipan International Airport.

For purposes of this section, "international deplaned passengers" is defined as all those deplaned passengers at the Saipan International Airport who did not originate in Tinian, Rota, or Guam and whose destination is Saipan. Guam transit passengers destined for Saipan shall not be included in the definition of "international deplaned passengers."

2. This amendment shall have effect only at the Saipan International Airport. All other sections of Part 12 remain in effect.

3. This amendment shall take effect upon its adoption by the Board of Directors and its promulgation in the manner provided by law.
