The Office of the Special Assistant for Administration, Office of the Governor, hereby provides Public Notice of its intention to "Repeal Existing Regulations Concerning Application and Procedures Regarding the Issuance of Certificates of Identity." The purpose of this repeal is to terminate the issuance of Certificates of Identity. This Repeal of Existing Regulations is promulgated under the Authority granted to the Office of the Special Assistant for Administration, Office of the Governor by the Governor's Executive Order 94-3, Section 201, and the CNMI Commonwealth Code including, but not limited to, the Commonwealth Administrative Procedure Act, 1 CMC, §9101 et seq.

Anyone interested in commenting on this proposed repealed regulation may do so, in writing, addressed to the Office of the Special Assistant for Administration, Office of the Governor, Caller Box 10007, Saipan, MP 96950, not later than thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this proposed repealed regulation in the CNMI Commonwealth Register.

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**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**EXPLANATION BY THE OFFICE OF THE SPECIAL ASSISTANT FOR ADMINISTRATION, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, OF ITS INTENTION TO REPEAL EXISTING REGULATIONS CONCERNING APPLICATION AND PROCEDURES REGARDING THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF IDENTITY**


It has been brought to this Office's attention that some residents of the Commonwealth continue to request the issuance of certificates of identity pursuant to 3 CMC, §4111 *et seq.* (Public Law 1-6) and the rules and regulations adopted by the Chief of Immigration Service pursuant to 3 CMC, §4123 (located in Volume 1 No. 2 of the Commonwealth Register, pages 47-52). However, the intended purpose of Public Law 1-6 has long been satisfied. The issuance of certificates of identity was intended to be for a limited duration and only for those residents defined by 4 CMC, §4111 to be interim citizens of the United States until such time as the Covenant was fully implemented with the official termination of the Trusteeship Agreement.

The termination occurred with the issuance of Presidential Proclamation No. 5564 on November 3, 1986. Afterwards, there was no further need for the Commonwealth Government to issue certificates of identity. The Proclamation effectively implemented Section 301 of the Covenant, thereby establishing the right of U.S. citizenship to those persons who had been deemed to be interim citizens. Those persons who had been interim citizens became eligible to apply for U.S. Passports.

U.S. citizens residing in the Commonwealth who desire to travel either to a foreign country or to another U.S. jurisdiction can and should do so with a U.S. Passport issued by the Passport Office of the U.S. Department of State. U.S. citizens residing in the Commonwealth are encouraged to file an application with our local U.S. Passport Office located at the Joeten Building in Dandan, Saipan, MP 96950. (Please refer to the attached documents for more information on Application Requirements for U.S. Passports, as well as other related info.).

Therefore, because there is no valid government function served by the continued issuance of such certificates, and in accordance with the Governor's September 12, 1995, memorandum, it is this Office's intention to repeal existing Rules and Regulations concerning application and procedures regarding the issuance of certificates of identity.



# PASSPORT APPLICATION

## FEDERAL TAX LAW:

Section 6039E of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires a passport applicant to provide his/her name (#1), mailing address (#2), date of birth (#5), and social security number (#6). If you have not been issued a social security number, enter zeroes in box #6. Passport Services will provide this information to the Internal Revenue Service routinely. Any applicant who fails to provide the required information is subject to a \$500 penalty enforced by the IRS. All questions on this matter should be referred to the nearest IRS office.

## ACTS OR CONDITIONS

(If any of the below-mentioned acts or conditions has been performed by or applies to the applicant, the portion which applies should be lined out, and a supplementary explanatory statement under oath (or affirmation) by the applicant should be attached and made a part of this application.)

I have not, since acquiring United States citizenship, been naturalized as a citizen of a foreign state; taken an oath or made an affirmation or other formal declaration of allegiance to a foreign state; entered or served in the armed forces of a foreign state; accepted or performed the duties of any office, post, or employment under the government of a foreign state or political subdivision thereof; made a formal renunciation of nationality either in the United States or before a diplomatic or consular officer of the United States in a foreign state; or been convicted by a court or court martial of competent jurisdiction of committing any act of treason against, or attempting by force to overthrow, or bearing arms against, the United States, or conspiring to overthrow, put down, or to destroy by force, the Government of the United States; or having been naturalized, within one year after such naturalization, returned to the country of my birth or any other foreign country to take up a permanent residence.

**WARNING:** False statements made knowingly and willfully in passport applications or in affidavits or other supporting documents submitted therewith are punishable by fine and/or imprisonment under provisions of 18 USC 1001 and/or 18 USC 1542. Alteration or mutilation of a passport issued pursuant to this application is punishable by fine and/or imprisonment under the provisions of 18 USC 1543. The use of a passport in violation of the restrictions contained therein or of the passport regulations is punishable by fine and/or imprisonment under 18 USC 1544. All statements and documents submitted are subject to verification.

## PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT:

The information solicited on this form is authorized by, but not limited to, those statutes codified in Titles 8, 18, and 22, United States Code, and all predecessor statutes whether or not codified, and all regulations issued pursuant to Executive Order 11295 of August 5, 1966. The primary purpose for soliciting the information is to establish citizenship, identity, and entitlement to issuance of a United States Passport or related facility, and to properly administer and enforce the laws pertaining thereto.

The information is made available as a routine use on a need-to-know basis to personnel of the Department of State and other government agencies having statutory or other lawful authority to maintain such information in the performance of their official duties; pursuant to a court order; and, as set forth in Part 171, Title 22, Code of Federal Regulations (see *Federal Register*, Volume 42, pages 49791 through 49795).

Failure to provide the information requested on this form may result in the denial of a United States Passport, related document, or service to the individual seeking such passport, document, or service.

**HOW TO APPLY FOR A U.S. PASSPORT.** U.S. passports are issued only to U.S. citizens or nationals. Each person must obtain his or her own passport.

**IF YOU ARE A FIRST-TIME APPLICANT**, please complete and submit this application in person. (Applicants under 13 years of age usually need not appear in person unless requested. A parent or guardian may execute the application on the child's behalf.) Each application must be accompanied by (1) **PROOF OF U.S. CITIZENSHIP**, (2) **PROOF OF IDENTITY**, (3) **TWO PHOTOGRAPHS**, (4) **FEES** (as explained below) to one of the following acceptance agents: a clerk of any Federal or State court; a notary public; a judge or clerk of any probate court accepting applications; a designated postal employee at a selected post office; or an agent at a Passport Agency in Boston, Chicago, Honolulu, Houston, Los Angeles, Miami, New Orleans, New York, Philadelphia, San Francisco, Seattle, Stamford, or Washington, D.C.; or a U.S. consular official.

**IF YOU HAVE HAD A PREVIOUS PASSPORT**, inquire about eligibility to use Form DSP-82 (mail-in application). Address requests for passport amendment, extension of validity, or additional visa pages to a Passport Agency or a U.S. Consulate or Embassy abroad. Check visa requirements with consular officials of countries to be visited well in advance of your departure.

**(1) PROOF OF U.S. CITIZENSHIP.**

(a) **APPLICANTS BORN IN THE UNITED STATES.** Submit previous U.S. passport or certified birth certificate. A birth certificate must include your given name and surname, date and place of birth, date the birth record was filed, and seal or other certification of the official custodian of such records. A record filed more than 1 year after the birth is acceptable if it is supported by evidence described in the next paragraph.

**IF NO BIRTH RECORD EXISTS**, submit registrar's notice to that effect. Also submit an early baptismal or circumcision certificate, hospital birth record, early census, school, or family Bible records, newspaper or insurance files, or notarized affidavits of persons having knowledge of your birth (preferably with at least one record listed above). Evidence should include your given name and surname, date and place of birth, and seal or other certification of office (if customary) and signature of issuing official.

(b) **APPLICANTS BORN OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES.** Submit previous U.S. passport or Certificate of Naturalization, or Certificate of Citizenship, or a Report of Birth Abroad, or evidence described below.

**IF YOU CLAIM CITIZENSHIP THROUGH NATURALIZATION OF PARENT(S)**, submit the Certificate(s) of Naturalization of your parent(s), your foreign birth certificate, and proof of your admission to the United States for permanent residence.

**IF YOU CLAIM CITIZENSHIP THROUGH BIRTH ABROAD TO U.S. CITIZEN PARENT(S)**, submit a Consular Report of Birth (Form FS-240) or Certification of Birth (Form DS-1350 or FS-545), or your foreign birth certificate, parents' marriage certificate, proof of citizenship of your parent(s), and affidavit of U.S. citizen parent(s) showing all periods and

places of residence/physical presence in the United States and abroad before your birth.

**(2) PROOF OF IDENTITY.** If you are not personally known to the acceptance agent, you must establish your identity to the agent's satisfaction. You may submit items such as the following containing your signature AND physical description or photograph that is a good likeness of you: previous U.S. passport; Certificate of Naturalization or of Citizenship; driver's license (not temporary or learner's license); or government (Federal, State, municipal) identification card or pass. Temporary or altered documents are not acceptable.

**IF YOU CANNOT PROVE YOUR IDENTITY** as stated above, you must appear with an **IDENTIFYING WITNESS** who is a U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien who has known you for at least 2 years. Your witness must prove his or her identity and complete and sign an Affidavit of Identifying Witness (Form DSP-71) before the acceptance agent. You must also submit some identification of your own.

**(3) TWO PHOTOGRAPHS.** Submit two identical photographs of you alone, sufficiently recent to be a good likeness (normally taken within the last 6 months), 2 x 2 inches in size, with an image size from bottom of chin to top of head (including hair) of between 1 and 1-3/8 inches. Photographs must be clear, front view, full face, taken in normal street attire without a hat or dark glasses, and printed on thin paper with a plain light (white or off-white) background. They may be black and white or color. They must be capable of withstanding a mounting temperature of 225° Fahrenheit (107° Celsius). Photographs retouched so that your appearance is changed are unacceptable. Snapshots, most vending machine prints, and magazine or full-length photographs are unacceptable.

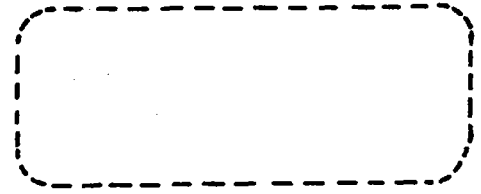
**(4) FEES.** Submit \$65 if you are 18 years of age or older. The passport fee is \$55. In addition, a fee of \$10 is charged for the execution of the application. Your passport will be valid for 10 years from the date of issue except where limited by the Secretary of State to a shorter period. Submit \$40 if you are under 18 years of age. The passport fee is \$30 and the execution fee is \$10. Your passport will be valid for 5 years from the date of issue, except where limited as above.

Pay the passport and execution fees in one of the following forms: checks—personal, certified, traveler's; bank draft or cashier's check; money order, U.S. Postal, international, currency exchange; or if abroad, the foreign currency equivalent, or a check drawn on a U.S. bank.

Make passport and execution fees payable to Passport Services (except if applying at a State court, pay execution fee as the State court requires) or the appropriate Embassy or Consulate, if abroad. No fee is charged to applicants with U.S. Government or military authorization for no-fee passports (except State courts may collect the execution fee). Pay special postage if applicable.

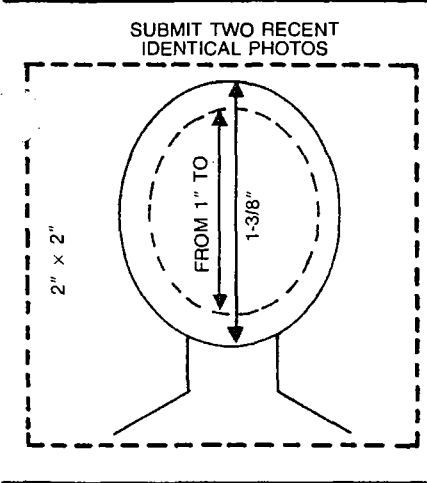

**APPLYING FOR EXPEDITED PASSPORT SERVICES**

**FEE FOR EXPEDITED SERVICE:** Effective October 1, 1994, a surcharge of \$30 per passport will be assessed for expedited service. **The fee applies to expedited processing for all passport service, including issuance, amendment, extension of validity, and adding visa pages.** Expedited passports will be processed **within three business days of receipt by a Passport Agency**, except when a passport must be denied or delayed. If the three-day processing deadline cannot be met, the expedite fee will be refunded. If desired, payment for overnight return of the issued passport should also be sent with the application.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR EXPEDITED PASSPORTS PROCESSING:** Expedited processing is available only for travelers who are leaving in less than ten (10) days and can document their departure with plane tickets or confirmed reservations. Travelers who need to obtain foreign visas to depart within two to three weeks may also request expedited service. Expedited service is not available to travelers who cannot document their travel.

**WHERE TO APPLY:** Travelers with very short deadlines may wish to apply directly at a Passport Agency (located in Boston, Chicago, Honolulu, Houston, Los Angeles, Miami, New Orleans, New York, Philadelphia, San Francisco, Seattle, Stanford (CT), and Washington, D.C.). However, many requests for expedited service can be handled by the more than 4,000 clerks of court and post offices which accept passport applications and forward then to Passport Services for issuance. If this option is selected, prepaid overnight delivery for each application is recommended both to and from the Passport Agency.

**WHERE TO APPLY LOCALLY:** Travelers with very short deadlines may apply at the U.S. Passport Office located at the Joeten Building in Dandan from Monday thru Friday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

**EXPEDITING PASSPORT RENEWALS BY MAIL:** Expedited passport renewals by mail must include applicable passport fees, proof of imminent departure and \$30 per passport. Mail applications to Honolulu Passport Agency, 1132 Bishop Street, Suite 500, Honolulu, HI 96813-2809. Clearly mark the envelope "EXPEDITE." Mailed application will be processed within three days of receipt.

**FINAL VERSION OF AMENDMENTS**  
**TO**  
**THE PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS FOR WORK CERTIFICATES**  
**FOR ALIEN GARMENT WORKERS**

Section 1.

**Authority.** These regulations are issued under the authority granted the Department of Labor and Immigration to certify nonresident workers pursuant to 3 CMC § 4435, 3 CMC § 4424 and E.O. 94-3 § 301. The proposed version of these regulations was published on August 16, 1995, beginning at page 13648.

Section 2.

**Purpose of Regulations.** These regulations amend the rules and regulations promulgated on January 19, 1988, and published at Vol. 10, No. 1, page 5414-5417, which place certain limitations on the issuance of labor and immigration permits for nonresident workers under the classification of garment worker. These amendments increase the legal number of labor and immigration permits that may be issued for the employment of nonresident garment workers to reflect and accommodate the changes in the industry. The amendments also make minor changes in the regulations to reflect the organizational changes made by E.O. 9-43.

Section 3.

**Amendments.** The Regulations Restricting the Issuance of Business Licenses to Garment Manufacturers and the Processing of Applications for Work Certificates for Alien Garment Workers (the "Regulations") filed with the Registrar on January 18, 1988, and modified by Regulation filed with the Registrar on May 15, 1989, are hereby amended as follows:

**A.** Current Subsection 2(g) is renumbered Subsection 2(h) and a new Subsection 2(g) is added as follows:

(g) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Labor and Immigration as established by E.O. 94-3, Section 301.

**B.** Current Subsection 2(h) is renumbered 2(i) and amended to read as follows:

(h) "Work Certificate" means a certificate of labor issuable by the Secretary pursuant to 3 CMC 4435(b).

**C.** The first sentence of Subsection 4(b)(1) is deleted and replaced with the following sentence:

Garment Worker Pool. There is hereby established a garment worker pool which shall consist of two thousand five hundred (2,500) additional quota and all unused or unfilled non-immigrant alien garment worker positions within the quota of a manufacturer.

**D.** The third sentence of Subsection 4(b)(2) is deleted and replaced with the following sentence:

All unused or unfilled non-immigrant alien garment worker quota(s) shall revert to the Garment Worker Pool for reallocation to qualified garment manufacturers, unless such unused or unfilled quota(s) is reused or refilled prior to the expiration of one hundred and eighty (180) days from the termination or expiration of the contract(s) giving rise to the unused or unfilled quota(s).

**E.** The first sentence of Subsection 4(b)(3) is deleted and replaced with the following:

Request for Pool Garment Worker. Any qualified garment manufacturer may apply for additional workers, not to exceed one hundred and twenty (120) workers, from the Garment Worker Pool provided that the applicant meets all of the criteria enumerated below in this Subsection 4(b)(3) as of the date of the application, and provided further that:

(i) No additional workers will be approved for any garment manufacturer who the Secretary determines was allowed additional workers above any previous quota allowed by these regulations;

(ii) No currently operating garment manufacture, as opposed to start-up garment manufacture, will be allowed additional workers in excess of twenty percent of such garment manufacturer's allowed workers



as reported in such manufacturer's semi-annual report as required by Section 4(b)(2) of these Regulations for the first half of 1995. With regard to start-up garment manufactures with a current quota of zero, the one hundred and twenty (120) worker limitation shall not apply as long as this Subsection 4(b)(3)(ii) is in effect pursuant to Subsection 4(b)(3)(iii).;

(iii) The restrictions provided in Subsections (i) and (ii), above, will remain in effect if and until such time as the Secretary determines that additional workers have become available in the Garment Worker Pool after a time in which the entire Garment Worker Pool, as first amended to include a total additional quota of two thousand five hundred (2,500), has been exhausted.

**F.** All references to the term "Department of Commerce and Labor" or "Department" in subsections 4(b), 4(b)(2), 4(b)(3), and 4(b)(5) are deleted and replace with term "Department of Labor and Immigration."

**G.** All references to the term "Director of Commerce and Labor" or "Director" in subsections 4(b), 4(b)(1), 4(b)(2), 4(b)(3), 4(b)(5), 4(b)(6), and current 4(b)(9), are deleted and replaced with the term "Secretary"


**H.** The term "garment manufacturer" in the first sentence of subsection 4(b)(5) is deleted and replace with the term "garment manufacturers."



J. Subsection 4(c) is deleted and replaced with the following:

(c) Issuance of Entry Permits. No employee of the Department of Labor and Immigration shall issue or cause to be issued an entry permit of behalf of a non-immigrant alien to be employed as a garment worker except upon the written finding by the Secretary (or the Secretary's designee) as prescribed in subsection (b) of this section.






